Greetings UWF friends,

I hope your local units are thriving with interesting programs and warm fellowship at your Circle meetings.

Here is some information about one of our Mission Spotlights: God's Country Cooperative Parish, (GCCP.) This very busy mission is located right in the middle of the Upper Peninsula of Michigan, in Newberry, and serves 300 families in 4 counties. Update: The situation has changed among its three supporting area churches, so it is no longer a cooperative. It is now a mission so the name has changed to GCCMission. It is still sponsored by the Board of Global Ministries of the UMC in New York.

This mission began when the Social Services in the area asked the area churches to consider running a mission because the needs of the are citizens, "is so great." An old stone school was for sale. Our Michigan

Conference bought the building and the United Methodists stepped up to the challenge. They hired a pastor, Randy Hildebrandt, and the rest is history. They eventually grew out of the old school and now in a brand new facility nearby.

This mission provides so much! It helps folks with gas cards for getting to work, work boots and work gloves, snowmobile maintenance in the winter, feminine hygiene products, clothing of all kinds, diapers, groceries and occasionally assistance with rent. They also provide Bibles for households which do not have them and counseling about decision making and how to rise out of poverty, and the list could go on. They even provide computers for those that wish to take high school or college courses online!
