### Understand & Interpret United Women in Faith's Mission: Utilize and Promote UWFaith Resources

United Women in Faith national office produces several publications that communicate our collective mission story. These publications connect our members to the work happening across the national organization and internationally. They allow us to see what we are enabling through our mission giving and participation.

### 1. response Magazine

response is an award-winning publication, is the official magazine of United Women in Faith and is published by the national office. Topics and issues cover spiritual growth, mission outreach and reports on our local, national and international work. Ensure each local unit and circle is subscribing and encourage members to purchase their own subscription.

#### 2. Faith Talks

Faith Talks is a monthly series of live conversations, or pod casts, that explore themes and resources that empower us to put faith, hope and love into action. You may participate in the pod casts live or listen to the recordings later. Encourage units to tune in!

#### 3. Mission Studies

Every year, United Women in Faith produces books for use as <u>mission studies</u> at Mission u. These books are great sources of information and learning and can be studied outside of the Mission u context. Encourage your units to have members attend Mission u.

### 4. Program Book & Prayer Journal

The <u>Program Book</u> is published annually as a program guide for UWFaith units. The <u>Prayer Journal</u> is a yearly planner that highlights the work of our missionaries and mission institutions across the country and around the globe.

### 5. Reading Program

The <u>Reading Program</u> is a cherished tradition that brings together members in mission as they explore, share and discuss the books. Encourage your units to participate in the Reading Program. Your district program resources person will also assist in promoting the Reading Program.

#### 6. Website and online resources

Numerous resources covering various topics are available for download on <u>the United Women in Faith website</u> (umfaith.org). United Women in Faith also has a <u>YouTube channel</u> with video resources spanning the full range our work.
