All children need and deserve a loving family to support their lifelong growth. Sadly, many older children in foster care lack permanent families. Older youth in foster care can attain permanence through one of three pathways: adoption, guardianship or reunification with their birth families.

A less favorable outcome is aging out (also known as emancipation). Youth grow too old to remain in foster care and exit the system without a permanent family.

More than 15,000 young people age out of the U.S. foster care system each year. It's a challenging starting point and one that, according to researchers, can carry lifelong consequences.
